

LATIN

Our Latin curriculum is designed to allow children to learn to read Latin accurately, confidently and with enjoyment. We focus on providing clear explanations of major grammatical concepts and sufficient opportunities to practise them that they develop a secure mastery of the language's fundamental building blocks. We also prioritise vocabulary, supporting children to learn a range of Latin words so that they can, in time, tackle more ambitious texts. While we value the subject for its own sake and for the pleasure that it brings, our teaching also aims to support children's command of the English language through our explicit focus on grammar and syntax, and through the study of English words derived from the Latin words they have learned.
